How can Cardiac Scoring benefit heart health?

This fast, painless CT scan can detect—or rule out—hidden signs of heart disease. It's recommended for patients age 40+ with certain risk factors, such as hypertension, high cholesterol, smoking, obesity, diabetes, or family history of heart disease.

- Tests for calcium in the coronary arteries (calcified plaque)—an indication of heart attack risk that can appear before symptoms show
- Assigns a risk score from zero (meaning almost no near-term heart disease risk) to 400+ for patients at high risk
- Like a cholesterol level, helps your doctor plan appropriate treatment
