SmartMamm[™] - 3D Digital Mammography

3D X-ray exam of the breast with computer-aided detection for maximum accuracy in the early detection of breast cancer. Princeton Radiology's SmartMamm[™] goes a step further by assessing your lifetime risk of breast cancer and including your personal risk score on your mammogram report, at no additional charge. Same day results available.

Smart Breast MRI[™]

A painless imaging exam without ionizing radiation that gives radiologists a closer look at breast tissue. Doctors may recommend breast MRI to further examine suspicious areas unresolved on a SmartMamm[™] or for women at higher risk for breast cancer, such as those with dense breasts or a family history of breast cancer. Two options are available to accommodate women with different risk profiles or insurance situations:

- Diagnostic Smart Breast MRI[™], which most private insurance plans cover if a woman can be shown to be at high risk or has a ruptured breast implant
- Smart Screen Breast MRI,[™] which uses selective image acquisitions shown to be more effective in finding lesions than mammography alone— recommended for concerned patients and their doctors in the absence of an insurance-covered condition for diagnostic breast MRI, with an out-of- pocket cost of \$375

Breast Ultrasound

May be recommended as a follow-up exam to acquire additional views of breast tissue after a suspicious SmartMamm[™], or as a supplemental screening for women at higher risk for breast cancer, such as women with dense breasts or a family history of breast cancer.

Breast Biopsy

A suspicious finding after a breast imaging exam may lead to a recommendation of a breast biopsy. During this procedure, tissue samples from suspicious areas are extracted from the breast by an Interventional Radiologist and sent for examination by a Pathologist. Princeton Radiology physicians perform minimally invasive MRI- and Ultrasound-guided breast biopsies in convenient and comfortable outpatient settings at our Monroe, Freehold and Wayne locations. The exams are fast, with minimal discomfort, and findings are reported promptly to your doctor to reduce the anxiety of waiting.

Pelvic/Prenatal Ultrasound

An exam that provides images of the female reproductive organs -such as the uterus, cervix, ovaries and fallopian tubes- to determine the cause of abnormal bleeding, presence of cysts, fibroids, or other potential abnormalities. During pregnancy, the ultrasound can be used to determine fetal age, and to assess the growth, development and position of the baby and placenta.

DXA Body Composition Analysis

A fast, safe, and painless X-ray scan that takes a precise measurement of the ratios of bone, lean muscle, and fatty tissue in the body. DXA Body Composition is more accurate than other body composition test available in settings like gyms and health clubs. It provides useful information for people on weight management programs, athletes, and others who take a proactive approach to their health and fitness.

Bone Densitometry (DXA)

As women age, their risk increases of a debilitating disease called osteoporosis. Loss of bone mass can make bones more brittle and prone to fracture. The hips and spine are especially vulnerable. Bone Densitometry (DXA) is a fast, painless screening X-ray exam that can detect osteoporosis or earlier stages of bone loss, providing doctors with information that supports decisions on treatment. For most women, the first screening is recommended at age 65, with possible follow-ups depending on results. For women at higher risk, screenings before age 65 may be recommended.

Vein Treatments

Varicose and spider veins can cause problems that are more than skin deep, such as physical pain and effects on one's self-confidence and emotional wellness.
